



BEFORE YOU BEGIN:

Decide whether you are playing individually or in teams; and whether you are playing indoors or outdoors. Also decide how long you want to play, and where you should meet when time is up.

HOW TO PLAY:

Each team is dealt 10 cards. Try to find the items on your cards as quickly as possible. The first team to find all their items wins. If nobody has finished when time is up, meet with your opponents and figure out who has found the most items. That is your winner!



Use common sense:

If an item is impossible to find in your area, replace it with a new card. Also, some items cannot be physically collected. In these cases, teams take a picture to prove they found the item. Don't collect living things and don't "borrow" other peoples' belongings.

ALTERNATE GAME PLAY FOR INDOORS:

To turn Scavenger Hunt into more of a race, draw 10 cards and place them where all players can see them. Yell "GO" and each player races to be the first to find the items on the cards. The first player to find all the items wins.
