
** Back Story



Men power










Honeymaren *




Earth GIANTS

Use pliers to open the jump ring.





Slide the lobster clasp onto the jump ring.

Slide the jump ring onto the last link of the chain and close it with the pliers.



Attach the *Frozen 2* charm and the bead charms to the chain to decorate it.








Make a simple knot with the ends of the cords.



Secure the knot with a drop of clear nail polish and cut off the excess lengths of cord after the knot.

Thread a gold bead (J) onto the ends of the cords.



8 C

Make another simple knot after the bead.



Attach the charm of your choice to decorate the bracelet.


Fold the 2 cords at 17 3/4 in (45 cm) from the ends.

Make a simple knot ¾ in (1 cm) from the fold using all the ends of the cord.




Make square knots using the 2 longer cords until you reach 21% in (5.5 cm) of length.














Make square knots for another 21% in (5.5 cm) of length.







Make a simple knot using all the ends of the cords.





Thread a gold bead (J) onto the cords.










Make square knots using the 2 longer cords until you reach 21% in (5.5 cm) of length. B 0 2 1/8 in (5.5 cm)






Make a simple knot using the end of the cords.

1 DISNEY FROZEN 2 CHARM










CLEAR NAIL POLISH (OR CRAFT GLUE)



Take one piece of cord (24 in / 60 cm) and fold it in half.


12 in (30 cm)

Pass the fold of the cord through the last link of the chain making a loop.



Pass the ends of the cord back through the loop and tighten them against the chain link.




Thread one gold bead (K) onto the ends of the cord and push it toward the chain.



Use the end of a cord (17 ¾ in / 45 cm) and make a simple knot beside the bead. It will secure the bead in place.




TO MAKE THREADING THE BEADS EASIER FOR THE NEXT STEPS, APPLY ONE DROP OF CLEAR NAIL POLISH TO THE END OF EACH CORD AND WAIT FOR IT TO DRY.

Start to braid the 3 cords together.



Tip

MAKE SURE THAT THE BEAD AND THE KNOT ARE WELL POSITIONED WHEN YOU BEGIN.




Thread a gold bead (M) onto the middle cord every time you braid two cords together.






Once you have threaded 9 beads, finish the braid and make a simple knot with the ends of the cords.







Measure ¾ in (1 cm) from the ends of the 3 cords and fold them over making a loop.




11 B

Tie the 3 cords together using a simple knot as shown. Tighten the knot as much as possible.

Secure the first knot with a drop of clear nail polish and cut off the excess lengths of cord after the knot.
