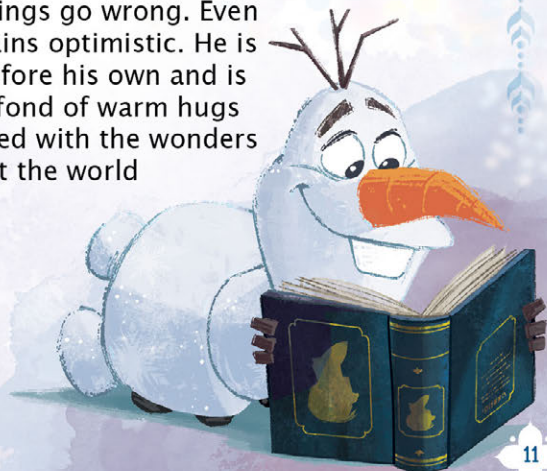

*Gale* IS THE WIND SPIRIT.

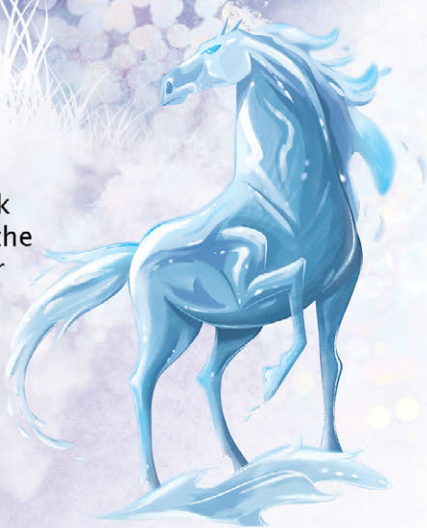
Gale is the first of the spirits to appear. This force taunts Elsa and the group by spinning them in its vortex.

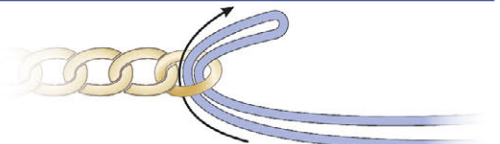
Take one piece of cord (24 in / 60 cm) and fold it in half.

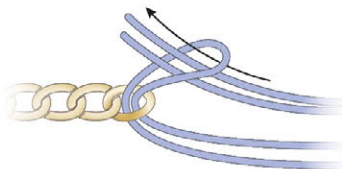

Pass the fold of the cord through the last link of the chain making a loop.



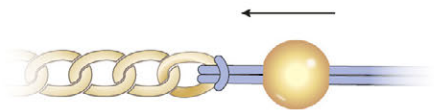

Pass the ends of the cord back through the loop and tighten them against the chain link.



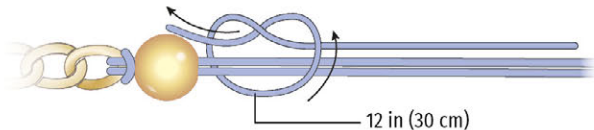

Use the end of a cord (17 3/4 in / 45 cm) and make a simple knot beside the bead. It will secure the bead in place.
